30. Elementary Pair Pace: Jumps 18"-2' Pair with the fewest jumping faults and who comes closest to option time without exceeding it wins. Only one of the pair needs to jump or you can switch jumps, team decides.
31. Pair Pace- Beginner Novice Level, Jumps not to exceed 2'6" Pair with the fewest jumping faults and who comes closest to option time without exceeding it wins. Only one of the pair needs to jump or you can switch jumps, team decides.
32. Pair Pace- Novice, Jumps not to exceed 3' Pair with the fewest jumping faults and who comes closest to option time without exceeding it wins. Only one of the pair needs to jump or you can switch jumps, team decides.
