1. Entries:

Entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee. BN competitors who are not USEA members must pay an extra \$25 USEA BN non-member fee with entry. \$30.00 fee for any changes or entries after closing date.

Double entries not accepted. Refunds: Before closing date.- less \$25 non-refundable office fee; After closing date.-Entry-no refund. Competition cancellation-less \$40.00. Negative Coggins within 12 months required for all horses out.-of.-state horses.

3. Awards:

4. Starting Times:

5. Stabling/Veterinarian:

\$25.00per night. 100 perm stalls on grounds – east side of racetrack within easy riding distance of event. Stall doors & initial bedding (2 bags) provided. Send stabling form & money with entry to secretary. **Please strip your stalls when you leave!** Veterinarian: Animal Medical Center, (307) 682-1507.

Send check for hook-up with entry. Bathrooms and showers in RV area. NO horses allowed in RV park!

7. Directions:

Address: Campex Equestrian Park, Fox Park Rd.Gillette, WY 82718

From I.90 East or West: Exit 129 south 1 mile. Campex facility on left. At 4-way stop intersection, take Boxelder east 1/2 mile to entrance of stabling.

From South Highway 59: At second traffic light, take Southern Dr. east & north. 2 miles to Campex, At 4-way stop intersection take Boxelder . 1/2 mile east to entrance of stabling. Follow sign to stabling, Cross- country course, 1/2 mile east of racetrack at the end of Boxelder Rd.

Test & arena sizes: P -2010 USEF Preliminary Test B-Sm. T-2010 USEF Training Test B-Sm. N-2010 USEF Novice Test B-Sm. BN-2010 USEF Beginner Novice & Intro Test B-Sm. Arenas: Sand.

9. Cross-Country:

P-2700 m @ 520 mpm. T-2400 m @ 420 mpm. N-2000 m @ 350 mpm. BN-1600 m @ 350 mpm/ 17-18 obstacles to 2'7". Intro courses to 2'3". All courses: Rolling, natural prairie; water on all courses – option for Intro. All times and distances are approximate.

10. Other Information:

All phases in one area, near stabling. Cross-country course closed June 24. Food on grounds. **DOGS MUST BE LEASHED**. Competitor Party: Saturday evening.
