Flat Classes/Dressage Jr/Sr 8:00

1. Beginner Rider Walk/Trot Equitation Western/English- Walk/Trot: For riders not ready to canter in a group. Can only enter additional classes #7 (Western), #9 (English), #14 (English or Western)
2. Leadline Western/English: May not enter any other classes: Walk only
3. Western Pleasure- Walk, Jog, Lope
4. Western Equitation- Walk, Jog, Lope
5. Dressage Suitability English- Walk, Trot, Canter
6. Dressage Equitation English- Walk, Trot, Canter

Classes 7-13- \$20.00 per class or \$50.00 for three dressage classes. Riders can have test reader. **Dressage entries must be received by February 8th. There are only a certain number of dressage rides available so get your entry in early.**

Show Jumping 1:00 Jr/Sr

Classes 14-20: \$15.00 per class, A and B are separate classes and each is a 15.00 entry fee or \$50.00 unlimited flat (classes 1-6) and jumping classes (classes 14-20) for same horse/rider combination

Two classes (A & B) with different courses are offered at each jump height. Separate ribbons (1-6) will be awarded for each class, both A and B.

Heeled boots and ASTM approved helmets with safety straps required for all jumping classes.

- 15. A & B Chicken Little Jumpers-Low X-Rails (not to exceed 12")
- 16. A & B Green Jumpers- 18"-2'

10 Minute Warm up for classes 17,18

- 17. A & B Elementary Jumpers- 2'3"-2'6"
- 18. A & B Beginner Novice Jumpers- 2'6"-2'-9"

10 Minute Warm up for classes 19,20

- 19. A & B Novice Jumpers- 3' Jumps
- 20. A & B Training Jumpers- 3'3" -3'6"Jumps
