At 4-way stop intersection, take Boxelder east 1/2 mile to entrance of stabling. From South Hwy 59: At second traffic light, take Southern Drive east and north 2 miles to Complex. At 4-way stop, take Boxelder Rd. 1/2 mile east to entrance of stabling. Follow sign to stabling Cross-country course 1/2 east of racetrack.
